Privacy Policy

Champions Against Bullying, Inc., a501c(3) non-profit organization, is committed to protecting your online privacy. The following explains what information we collect about you, how we use it, and what choices you have regarding this information. This policy applies to all information collected from or submitted to championsagainstabullying.org, championsagainstabullying.com and any potential future affiliated site containing championsagainstabullying sub-domain combined with any top-level domain.

What We Know About You

In general, you can browse this site without telling us who you are or revealing any personal information about yourself. As with many websites, this site automatically recognizes your domain name, IP address, browser version, operating system, and the referring site you passed through to reach our site. These do not specifically identify you. This information is used for website traffic analysis and is treated confidentially.

Any additional information you provide us — such as your name, organization, address, telephone number, email address, and interests — is collected only upon your consent. You must, for example, provide such information whenever you sign up for an email newsletter, register for an event, make a donation, or make an online purchase.

How We Use What We Learn

Information we collect is used to improve the content of our sites and to provide you with any information or support you've requested. We also compile and use this information so that we may keep you apprised of Champions Against Bullying, Inc. events or conferences; evaluate your job application; confirm receipts of payments events or conferences; evaluate your job application; confirm receipts of payments for products and/or services or donations; communicate with you about products and/or services purchased; communicate with you about our own, affiliated organization's or other third-party products or services that may interest you; or to comply with financial regulations and the law.

Your information will be shared with affiliates of Champions Against Bullying, Inc. including Right To Succeed Foundation, Go All Creative, Inc., Unleashed Media Group and Landmark Consulting Group, Inc. as well as any other official affiliates that may exist in the future.

We may contact you to notify you regarding your account, to troubleshoot problems with your account, to resolve a dispute, to collect fees or monies owed, to poll your opinions through surveys or questionnaires, to send updates about our company, or as otherwise necessary to contact you to enforce our User Agreement, applicable national laws, and any agreement we may have with you. For these purposes we may contact you via email, telephone, text messages, and postal mail.

How We Store, Use, Share and Disclose Your Personal Information

Our organization's web services are hosted on the GoDaddy.com platform. GoDaddy.com provides us with the online platform that allows us to sell our products and services to you. Your data may be stored through GoDaddy.com's data storage, databases and the general GoDaddy.com applications. They store your data on secure servers behind a firewall.

How We Use "Cookies" and Why

Our site uses "cookies" to improve your navigation through the site and to help us make the site more useful to you. A "cookie" is a small text file on your computer's hard drive that our site uses to collect information about how you use our site. The cookie transmits this information back to our site each time you visit a page on our site, thus allowing us to identify our most popular pages, features, and data. We use this information to improve our site to more effectively meet your needs.

Our site also uses cookies to communicate with Google Analytics for web-traffic analysis. These third-party cookies are collected and managed anonymously and do not contain any personally identifying information. To best serve you, our Google Analytics data retention does not automatically expire.

You can control or delete cookies as you wish. You can delete all cookies that are already on your computer and you can set most browsers to prevent them from being placed.

How We Communicate With You

We may contact you to notify you regarding your account, to troubleshoot problems with your account, to resolve a dispute, to collect fees or monies owed, to poll your opinions through surveys or questionnaires, to send updates about our company, or as otherwise necessary to contact you to enforce our User Agreement, applicable national laws, and any agreement we may have with you. Choices You Have

If you wish to opt-out of receiving communications from us at any time, please let us know by emailing, calling, or writing us (see contact information below). How We Will Protect Your Personal Information

We take appropriate physical, electronic, and managerial measures to ensure that we keep your information secure, accurate, and up-to-date. We will keep your data only as long as is reasonable and necessary or until you ask us to delete it.

We will keep your information confidential except where disclosure is required or permitted by law (for example, to government bodies and law enforcement agencies).
